Introduction

Infinity Blockchain Labs Company Limited ("**we**" or "**us**" or "**our**" or "**the Company**") and its affiliates respect your privacy, and we are committed to keeping your personal information confidential and secure ("**Your information**"). This Privacy Policy is designed to assist you in understanding how we collect, use, and disclose the information you provide us when accessing or using our website www.PLUTX.io ("**this Website**").

By accessing and using our Services, including accessing, using or registering an account on our PLUTX Enterprise Wallet ("**PLUTX Wallet**"), you signify acceptance to the terms of this Privacy Policy. Where we require your consent to process your personal information, we will ask for your consent to the collection, use, and disclosure of Your information as described further below. We may provide additional "just-in-time" disclosures or additional information about the data collection, use and sharing practices of specific Services. These notices may supplement or clarify our privacy practices or may provide you with other choices for how we process your data.

If you do not agree with or you are not comfortable with any aspect of this Privacy Policy, you should immediately discontinue your use of our Services and this Website.

WHAT INFORMATION DO WE COLLECT FROM YOU?

These details may include (where applicable), but not limited to:

- Name;
- Address;
- Telephone number;
- E-mail;
- Any information about you when you register to use our PLUTX Wallet and/or other Services, and when you use our PLUTX Wallet and/or other Services;
- All information which you submit to us in respect of any services provided on this Website, which information may include personal information;
- Some information about your computer or mobile device when you use our Services. This information may include:
 - The type of web browser and operating system you have used to access this Website or our Services;

- Your IP address (which is a number automatically assigned to your computer when you access the Internet and can be used to derive your general geographic location);
- Your device information (which may include information about the mobile device you use to access this Website, including the hardware model, operating system and version, unique device identifiers, and mobile network information);
- The amount of time you spent;
- Information about the features you access that we collect using cookies, Web beacons, and similar technologies.

HOW DO WE USE YOUR INFORMATION?

We may use Your information for the Purposes of:

- Ensuring that content from this Website is presented in the most effective manner for you and your computer;
- Providing you with information, products or services that you request from us or which we feel they may interest you, where you have consented to be contacted for such purposes;
- Answering your inquiry or responding to a communication from you;
- Allowing you to participate in interactive features of our service when you choose to do so;
- Notifying you of technical notices, support or administrative notifications;
- Communicating with you about news, products, services, events, and other information we think they will be of interest to you;
- Fulfilling our legal or regulatory requirements;
- Carrying out any other purpose or reason for which Your information was collected.

RECEIVING INFORMATION FROM THIRD PARTIES

We may receive information about you from third parties we work closely with, including business partners, sub-contractors in technical, payment and delivery services, advertising networks, analytics providers, search information providers, data verification/credit reference agencies.

We use this information by combining it with the information you give us and the information we collect about you for the Purposes set out above.

DIRECT MARKETING MATERIAL

From time to time we may contact you with information regarding promotions, competitions, and ancillary products via email. However, you will have the choice to opt in or out of receiving such communications by so indicating on the Website. You will also be given the opportunity on every e-communication that we send you to indicate that you no longer wish to receive our direct marketing material.

WHO DO WE SHARE YOUR INFORMATION WITH?

We may share Your information with:

- companies within our group, including but not limited to subsidiaries, other businesses, suppliers and subcontractors who have a contract with us to provide us with services. Those suppliers include credit reference/data verification agencies.
- appropriate authorities if we suspect that a registration involves any form of criminality, including identity theft, or money laundering and fraud prevention agencies if we determine that there has been fraud which meets the reporting criteria law enforcement, or other official authorities if we think it is the right thing to do, or we receive a court order requiring us to disclose another business if we buy/sell any business or assets from/to them, or are otherwise combined with that business (including during any negotiations with them) to third parties if we are under a duty to disclose or share Your information with them in order to comply with any legal obligation, or in order to enforce or apply our terms of use and other agreements, or to protect the rights, property, or safety of us, registered token holders, or others. This includes exchanging information with other companies and organizations for the purposes of fraud protection and with credit risk reduction advertisers and advertising networks that require the information to select and serve relevant adverts to you and others. We do not disclose information about identifiable individuals to our advertisers, but we will provide them with aggregate information about our users (for example, we may inform them that 500 men aged under 30 have clicked on their advertisements on any given day). We may

also use such aggregate information to help advertisers reach the kind of audience they want to target (for example, women in a particular geographic area). We may make use of the personal data we have collected from you to enable us to comply with our advertisers' wishes by displaying their advertisement to that target audience analytics and search engine providers that assist us in the improvement and optimization of our website.

WHERE DO WE KEEP YOUR INFORMATION?

The data that we collect from you may be transferred to and stored at a destination outside the European Economic Area ("**EEA**") and comply with the Cybersecurity Law of Vietnam. It may also be processed by staff operating outside the EEA who work for one of our suppliers or us. Such staff maybe engaged in, among other things, the fulfillment of your order, the processing of your payment details and the provision of support services. By submitting Your information, you agree to this transfer, storing or processing. We will take all steps reasonably necessary to ensure that Your information is treated securely and in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

Where we have given you (or where you have chosen) a password which enables you to access certain parts of our Website and/or Services, you are responsible for keeping this password confidential. We ask you not to share the password with anyone.

Unfortunately, the transmission of information via the internet is not completely secure. Although we will do our best to protect Your information, we cannot guarantee the security of your data transmitted to our Website; any transmission is at your own risk. Once we have received Your information, we will use strict procedures and security features to try to prevent unauthorized access.

ADDITIONAL TERMS APPLIED FOR EUROPEAN

If you are individual citizens of the European Union (EU) and the European Economic Area (EEA) under The General Data Protection Regulation (EU), you have rights as an individual in relation to Your information we hold. These rights include:

- The right to object to direct marketing – your preferences, including in relation to direct marketing, can be found in your account;

- The right to access the personal data that we process about you. Upon request, we will provide you with a copy of all the personal data we have on you.
- The right to request the deletion of your personal data. Upon request, we will delete all of Your information stored on our servers. Please be aware that given the immutable nature of blockchain technology, we may not be able to fully delete every piece of information (such as public keys, transaction records, etc.). However, we will do everything possible to fully comply with every request, and we will design future products with the right to deletion in mind.
- The right to request the rectification of Your information. You can manage and change some of this information in your account.

This Website uses cookies to enable us to improve our service to you and to provide certain features that you may find useful. Cookies are small text files that are transferred to your computer's hard drive through your web browser to enable us to recognize your browser and help us to track visitors to our Website; thus enabling us to understand better the products and services that will be most suitable to you.
